As Trustee of Union Township, Hendricks County, Indiana, pursuant to IC 6-1.1-17-16, I am requesting that the Department of Local Government Finance increase the levy for the repayment of the emergency fire loan previously approved by the Township Board on July 29, 2014 to an amount that will permit the repayment of that loan during calendar year 2015. At the time Union Township decided to incur the emergency loan for calendar year 2014, the field representative from the DLGF advised that the township could repay that loan over three (3) years pursuant to IC 36-6-6-14(f). In reliance on this advice, on July 29, 2014 the Township Board approved an emergency loan with a three (3) year repayment schedule. No remonstrance was filed. The Township included, in its budget, the amount necessary to repay the emergency loan over a three (3) year period.
